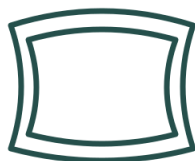

Eight clues, one easy game

Before you begin

Choose one room and stay with the children. Put objects in plain sight at child height. Use a clean empty plastic cup. Bring a hand towel into the room before starting. Point rather than collect. No climbing, opening drawers, or moving heavy furniture. Skip anything unavailable. A cushion or another stuffed animal is a good substitute.

1. BOOK

I have pages you can turn and pictures or stories inside.

2. SOCK

I keep one foot cozy and usually have a partner.

3. CUP

You can drink from me, but today I am empty.

4. TEDDY BEAR

I am a soft toy you can cuddle. I might have round ears and a little nose.

5. CHAIR

I have a seat where someone can sit.

6. TOWEL

I help dry your hands after you wash them.

7. PILLOW

I am soft and give your head a place to rest.

8. SHOE

I go on a foot when you are getting ready to go out.

Make it your own

Easier: show one picture at a time and search together. Pointing counts.
Harder: read the clue before showing the picture, then describe one detail.
Together: take turns choosing the next picture. Use one shared checklist.
